- Distributing essential supplies during natural disasters, pandemics, and other crises.



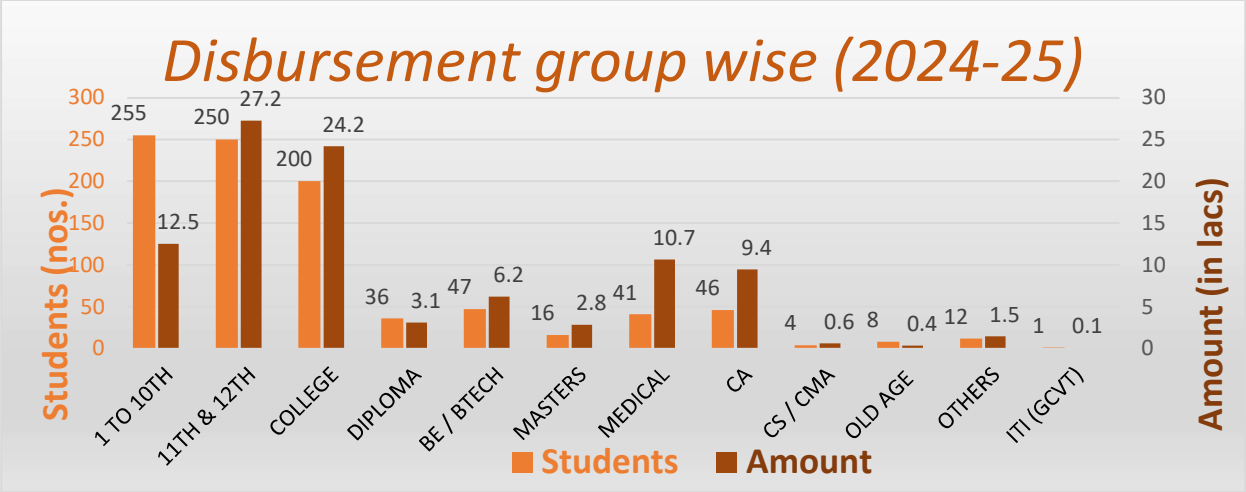

## Achievements

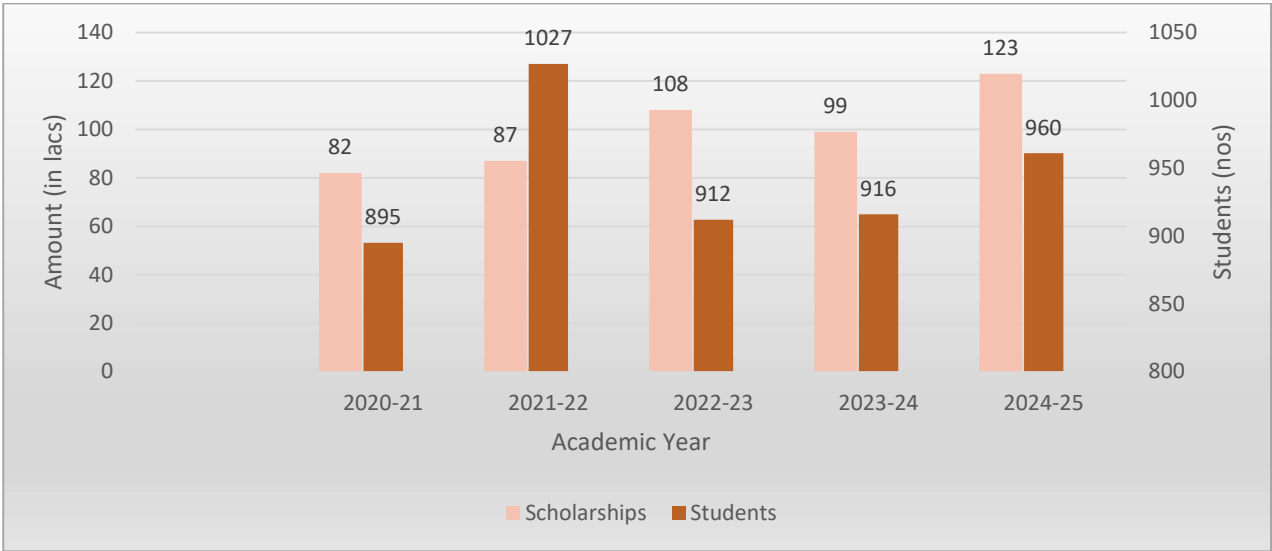

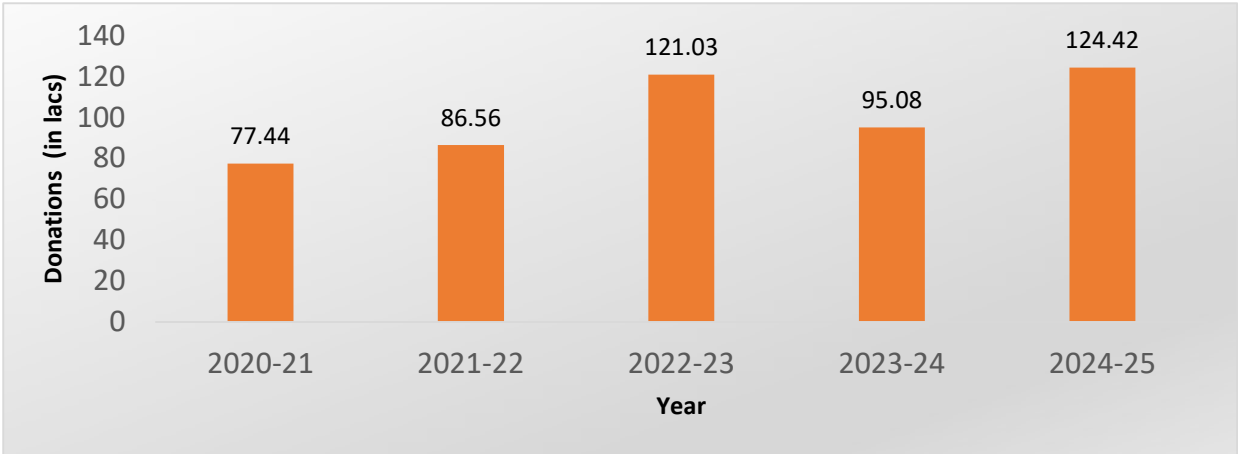
## Scholarships Disbursement Summary of the Last Five Years
